The 7th Annual WIMCO Charitable Foundation Golf Tournament was a tremendous success, raising \$85,500 to support nonprofit organizations across Eastern North Carolina. Primary beneficiaries included Daughters for Dads, Joy Soup Kitchen, and Eagle's Wings Food Pantry, each receiving \$28,500 to further their meaningful work in the community. Additional proceeds from raffle and mulligan sales provided a \$3,400 contribution to Bright Futures Beaufort County, supporting its mission to strengthen partnerships, meet student needs, and promote educational success throughout Beaufort County.




Amazon Teacher Wishlist Drive

The WIMCO Charitable Foundation proudly invested \$10,000 to support educators across Eastern North Carolina through its annual Amazon Teacher Wishlist initiative. Through this program, 100 PreK–12 teachers from eligible counties were each selected to receive \$100 in classroom supplies, helping equip them with essential resources for a successful school year.

Participants were required to meet regional eligibility guidelines and submit an application, with recipients chosen through a randomized selection process. This initiative reflects the Foundation’s continued commitment to supporting educators and strengthening classrooms throughout the communities we serve.



Cherryanne's Wish

On October 4, the Washington community rallied around Cherryanne Haddock for Cherryanne's Wish, a BBQ fundraiser she led in support of Shriners Children's Hospital. We were honored to help bring additional awareness to her initiative and invite our foundation community to contribute through the WIMCO Charitable Foundation, with all Venmo donations matched through the weekend to further support her efforts.

Through the generosity of our contributors, \$4,750 was raised and donated to Shriners Hospital in South Carolina. At the time we connected with Cherryanne, she had already raised an incredible \$53,000 on her own. Her compassion and determination at such a young age are truly inspiring, and we were grateful for the opportunity to stand alongside her and support the meaningful work she began.





Jones Cottage Renovation

The WIMCO Charitable Foundation is proud to share the successful completion of the Jones Cottage renovation at the Kennedy Home in Kinston, North Carolina, finalized in April 2025. The Jones Cottage, a ministry of Baptist Children's Homes of North Carolina, provides temporary housing and support for women and children escaping crisis situations and working toward stability and independence.

With the generous partnership of **Salisbury Moore, Lowe's, Blizzard Contract Flooring, Bradley Woodcraft, Pro356 Electric, A&R Painting, and Enviro Assessments East**, the home underwent a comprehensive renovation including new appliances, flooring, cabinetry, plumbing fixtures, shower inserts, paint, furnishings, and linens. We are also incredibly thankful for the overwhelming support from our community in fulfilling the Amazon Wishlist, supplying essential items such as diapers, baby gear, linens, toys, books, toiletries, and kitchen necessities. This collective generosity transformed the cottage into a fully equipped, welcoming home—ready to serve courageous mothers and their children with comfort, dignity, and hope.

Continuing one of our favorite traditions, several of our WIMCO kids once again helped select toys for our annual Toys for Tots collection, bringing extra joy and meaning to this seasonal effort. Grimesland Family Home Renovation

Following a devastating kitchen fire, the WIMCO Charitable Foundation stepped in to assist a Navy veteran mother, her three autistic children, and her father in rebuilding their home and restoring stability for their family.

The project included a complete kitchen renovation with new appliances, new furniture, LVT flooring and trim throughout the downstairs, new mattresses, TVs, blinds, and curtains throughout the home, and installation of two combo washer/dryer units. The downstairs jacuzzi tub was removed and reconfigured to better meet the family's needs, and miscellaneous maintenance items were addressed to ensure the home was fully move-in ready. The backyard was also fully transformed, with removal of turf and a pool, installation of sod and an in-ground trampoline, and a Vuly playset scheduled for installation in early spring.

This project was made possible through the generosity of community partners and donors who contributed time, services, materials, discounted pricing, and essential household items through the family's Amazon wishlist. Special thanks to **Thomas Electric, Harrison Tile, Blizzard Contract Flooring, DCH Enterprises, AP Backflow & Plumbing and Atlantic Stoneworks** for donating their time, services, and materials, and to Greenville Appliance and Garris Evans for their generous pricing support.

In January, the home was officially turned back over to the family—fully restored, refreshed, and ready for a new chapter.



Task Force Keystone Trailer

The WIMCO Charitable Foundation proudly purchased and donated a 7'x16' enclosed cargo trailer to Task Force Keystone, enhancing their ability to mobilize quickly and transport critical equipment and supplies during disaster response efforts.

Task Force Keystone is a veteran and first responder-led, volunteer-driven organization formed in response to Hurricane Helene. Over a 10-day deployment, the team conducted supply runs, provided medical coverage, and coordinated more than 20 helicopter landings to deliver aid to isolated communities. Working alongside local, state, and federal partners, they helped stabilize impacted areas and connect small communities with essential resources, ultimately serving well over one hundred individuals.

This investment strengthens their readiness for future emergencies and supports their ongoing mission to serve communities in times of greatest need.
